Digital technologies for nudging and rewarding: the WOM platform and its pilots in Italy

Alessandro Bogliolo is full professor of Computer Systems at the University of Urbino, Italy. This Guest Talk presents an anonymous digital rewarding platform, called WOM (Worth One Minute), and its pilot applications in Italy. WOM is a generalpurpose voucher system that recognizes the positive impact of actions and activities done by individuals that are



capable of triggering positive externalities and contributing to the common good.


